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# A NOTE ON THE ACTIVITIES OF OUR ORGANISATION

**Soham Academy of Human Excellence was started on May 09, 2017, with a motto of complementing the efforts of the schools in doing what they are unable to do and in teaching what they are not equipped to teach.**

Our Objectives include:

- **Create Institutions of Excellence:** Establish academies, schools and institutions to train a new generation of well-informed and well-educated citizens of India. Establish libraries and reading programmes in schools and colleges to promote reading of good books and literature. Establish the necessary facilities, events and trophies to encourage sports in schools and colleges.
- **Promote Excellence in Teaching:** Promote excellence in all spheres of life through design, development and implementation of innovative programmes in mathematics, physical and biological sciences, social sciences, yoga, sports, athletics, general knowledge, spoken English, communication skills, value education, music and life skills and their allied fields. Publish various books and journals, both in digital and print format, that bring out the best practices in teaching and learning.
- **Honour Excellence in Teaching:** Institute awards under various categories to honour educationists and those in teaching profession for their outstanding contributions towards excellence in teaching.
- **Extend Support for Excellence:** Establish and support various schemes and scholarships to support the education of the children from underprivileged sections of the society.
- **Stimulate Excellence at All Levels:** Organise seminars, workshops and cultural events in schools and colleges to promote excellence in education and to nurture innate talents in music, drama and culture.

These programs aim to bring out the best in the future citizens of our great nation. Through our programs we are now supporting several schools and colleges and a few like-minded organizations.
- We do not charge anything for our programs - either from our students or from our supported schools. All our activities, both big and small, are all done free of cost. This decision of ours helped thousands of children in getting benefitted by our programs. We wish to keep it that way so as to benefit many more.
- All our children are from the neediest, and below the poverty line, sections of the society. These children go to government, aided and budget schools. They need opportunities to excel and be hopeful of a bright future. That is why all our programs are free of charge. We want more and more of such children to excel in life.
- We work with children from all religious, caste and gender backgrounds. We do not discriminate children based on their social or religious backgrounds. We consistently promote children from all sections of society to mingle together. They are all encouraged to work together towards a great future for themselves as well for the nation.
- We understand that most of our children do not come well prepared to our programs especially during holidays. To help them stay alert and strong, we provide them with all the necessary breakfast and lunch arrangements, at absolutely no cost to them.
- For our children to participate in athletics, sports and yoga programs, we provide them the necessary equipment, shorts, tracks and shirts at absolutely no cost to them.
- During the COVID-19 times, we realized that many of our children and their families were going through several financial problems. To cater to their needs, we arranged for free groceries and other daily essentials.

- Many of our children were unable to attend their online school classes and also our online programs. To encourage their participation, we gave them free smart phones along with a fully paid recharge for one year.
- In most cases when children are unable to join our programs because of the transportation costs, we provide them with free transportation.

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF OUR ACTIVITIES

We started our activities in the second half of the 2016-17 academic year with a modest count of 2 activities covering about 100 students in one school. This program reached its peak in 2019-20 with 79 activities covering over 2,830 students in as many as 10 schools. The program continued in the shadows of the COVID-19 pandemic with several online activities. Thanks to the support of our sponsors, we've seen a dramatic increase in the momentum of our activities in the following academic years. As of March 31, 2024, we're working with 218 schools in many districts across the two Telugu-speaking state.

## ABOUT OUR PROGRAMS

### 1. English Proficiency

The schools made us write first, read next, and speak last. We learnt our mother tongue in the reverse sequence. We spoke first, read next and wrote last. We want you to adopt the same strategy when learning English. At Soham Academy of Human Excellence, we took this approach of learning English in the ways that mimic the way we learnt our mother tongue.



### 2. Learning to Learn

In the rush to get syllabus covered, most school teachers are failing to uncover the knowledge. Imagine what would happen if all the schools focus on learning methodologies first and then the other subjects! At Soham Academy of Human Excellence we like to focus on teaching.

- how to learn something new.
- how to ask questions.
- how to raise and sustain one's own curiosity levels.
- how to overcome fears of subjects like math and sciences.
- how to observe and discern information.



### 3. Yoga for Mind & Body

We want to teach yoga to our children for the simple reason that it offers some very obvious advantages. Staying fit and healthy is clearly one of them. Yoga has all the well documented benefits in terms of physical and mental stability as well as improved concentration levels. What is even more important, from our observation, is that the children are being habituated into doing difficult things. This is very important in the long run as they will not cringe whenever they encounter something that is challenging and difficult.



## 4. Athletics & Sports

At Soham Academy of Human Excellence, we believe that participation in athletics and sports is as important as learning sciences, math and languages. We can say it with confidence that a sharp mind sits more commonly in a fit body. A fit body is made possible by sustained participation in games and sports.



We strongly encourage all our kids to participate in 5K and 10K races. Fortunately, these events are available throughout the year in almost every nook and corner of our country. We also encourage our children to take up and excel in at least one team sport and one individual sport. We routinely take our kids to participate in 5K and 10K races as well as to Kabaddi & Kho-Kho tournaments.

## 5. Human Excellence

At Soham Academy of Human Excellence, it is our constant endeavour to make this world a better place for all beings. It starts at an individual level and later spreads to our homes, our community, our state, our nation and our world. Our focus is always at an individual level. A vast number of individuals must succeed in their honest pursuits of human excellence. It is these altruistic individuals who can usher in a safe and peaceful world. Our human excellence component focuses on creating such individuals. It is the underlying glue that binds all our programs. Our programs towards this end include:



- classes on classical music and dance through our Soham Suswara and Dance programs.
- painting and drawing classes.

- structured reading programs of various levels.

## 6. Bridging the Math Gap

Yet if you measure their intelligence just on their math skill you are likely to find some not so bright kids in every class. In many high school classrooms, in almost all the schools, you will come across children who cannot solve a simple primary school math problem. We at Soham Academy think that at some point or the other there should be an option for high school kids to understand some fundamentals in math. Our Bridging the Math Gap course attempts to do the same.



## 7. Robotics in Academics

Not so long-ago technology was largely very complex. One needed years of training to work on prototyping electronic projects. Working with electronic kits was very difficult. Fast forward to these days. YouTube and Google made it even more convenient to learn something new. Designing and executing electronics projects or writing computer programs is now relatively very easy.



At Soham Academy of Human Excellence, we believe that we can do our bit to transform schools. We can certainly complement the efforts of the schools in adapting to the technological shifts that are taking place on a day-to-day basis. We are continuously developing new-age projects that can be implemented by school children. We have put in every effort to make it easy to follow and executive Artificial Intelligence and Robotics projects.

## 8. Soham Leadership Program

We want our students to be our future leaders in our villages, districts, cities and states. We want them to excel and take up leadership roles in whatever profession they pick up. We wish them nothing but the best and through them the best for our nation. This program is in its third year now (as of March 2023). It operates under several categories including –

# 2016-2017

## 1. English Proficiency

# 2019-2020

## 1. Human Excellence Program at 8 Schools

As part of the 2019 Soham Champs Human Excellence program, children learnt to recite 36 shlokas and also articulate their meanings. In addition to this, they also learnt some classical and patriotic songs. The children who learnt these shlokas and songs were encouraged to teach other children in their schools. On the whole about 150 students were part of this program from 8 different schools.



## 2. Robotics Program at 10 Schools

As part of the 2019 Soham Champs Robotics program, training was done in two phases – Level 1 & Level 2 to 280 students at 10 different schools at different timings by different coordinators. Each level was for about 10 days. Kids learnt about modern electronic prototyping platforms in Level 1. In Level 2, they created simple robotics equipment that mimics real life.



## 3. Yoga Training at 9 Schools

Under the 2019 Soham Champs Yoga training program, we successfully trained 250 children from 9 schools in basic and advanced yoga routines. Through teamwork, they excelled in executing multiple yoga formations. Furthermore, we assisted the schools in seamlessly integrating yoga activities into their respective events, promoting a holistic approach to well-being.





## 4. Sports Training for Kabaddi, Kho-Kho & 5K/10K
